



MEMORENDUM of UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

BETWEEN

ARTICLE- II: EFFECTIVE DATE AND DURATION OF MOU

- a) This MoU shall be effective from the date of its approval by competent authorities at both ends.
- b) The duration of the MoU shall be valid for a period of 2 years from the effective date.
- c) During its tenancy, the MoU may be extended or terminated by a prior notice of not less than four months by either party. However, termination of the MoU will not in any manner affect any event that has already been planned and advertised.
- d) Any clause or article of the MoU may be modified or amended by mutual agreement of ARICON and HRDI.

ARTICLE-III: CONFIDENTIALITY

During the tenure of the MoU both ARICON and HRDI will maintain strict confidentiality and prevent disclosure of all the information and data exchanged under the scope of this MoU for any purpose other than in accordance with this MoU.

ARTICLE-IV: AMENDMENTS

Any amendment and/or addenda to the AGREEMENT shall be in writing and signed by the PARTIES hereto and shall only after such execution be deemed to form part of the AGREEMENT and have the effect of modifying the AGREEMENT to the extent required by such amendment or addenda.

After this Agreement has been signed, all preceding understandings/negotiations and correspondence pertaining to it shall become null and void.
